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GUIDELINES FOR CHECKING THE COURSE

General Observations:

1. Is there a specified save assembly area?
2. Is there safety signage when entering the shoot site?
3. Are there sufficient markers/signage to and from shooting lanes for all archers to make it around the course safely?
4. Is the lane number sign clearly visible from the trail on approach?
5. Is any part of the trail in danger from the next group of archers?
6. Is a warning at the morning brief necessary?
7. Is a warning sign at the target number sign needed?
8. Should the trail be moved?

At the shooting peg (each one):

9. Are the shooting pegs visible from the area of the target number (where people will stop to look)?
10. Are there separate shooting pegs for Juniors? Cubs? Beavers?
11. Should there be pegs for separate classes for this target? i.e Compound and sighted archers
12. Is there safe footing?
13. Is the target clearly visible?
14. Is there enough of a lane for archers to shoot safely? i.e right and left handed/ short and tall people
15. Is there clearance for the higher arcing arrow trajectory required by traditional bows?
16. Should any of the pegs be adjusted?

At the target:

17. Is the target securely mounted?
18. Is there sufficient ground for over shoots?
19. What is the backstop? Is it too hard (broken arrows)? Too soft (buried arrows)?
20. Should the target be adjusted?

21. Shooting Platforms (General Safety, Guardrails, Ladders, Rope to raise bow)
22. Moving Targets (General Safety of Target Area, Possible effects of shooting Moving Target)
